
EVENING PRAYER FOR LENT





The "I AM" Sayings

John 6:25-40; 8:12-20; 10:7-18; 14:6-14; 15:1-11

This illumination from the text of the Saint John's Bible displays five of Jesus' I AM sayings in the Gospel of John. From left to right: I AM the Bread, I AM the Gate, I AM the Way, I AM the Light, I AM the True Vine. Each name adds to the attributes of Christ and is a living symbol of who Christ is.

At the base of the columns is the ineffable Hebrew name for the Lord God "YHWH" (I am who I am). This name is written without vowels, signifying that it cannot be spoken aloud.

A framed reproduction print of this illumination is on display as you enter the worship space.

Grace of God Lutheran Church


Oakdale, Minnesota

Tonight we continue our Lenten journey. Lent is a time to focus our thoughts on Jesus and his suffering and death for us. Our theme for Evening Prayer is based on Jesus' words recorded in the Gospel of John.

God revealed himself to Moses in the burning bush as "I AM." This is the name by which the Old Testament people knew God. Jesus identified himself with God when he said to the Jewish leaders, "Before Abraham was, I AM." Now we meet "I AM" face to face in Christ. Jesus' words "illuminate" the promises of Jesus for us. Tonight we will focus on Jesus' words: "I AM the Bread of Life." We will hear testimony tonight from an imaginary biblical witness to Jesus' words.


SERVICE OF LIGHT

John 6:48-54

If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." ⁵² Then the Jews began to argue sharply among themselves, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" ⁵³ Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. ⁵⁴ Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.




